Please note: This is our vision in reaching the ultimate desired campus. Based on funding, and interest, plans and priorities will change. New proposals and ideas are always encouraged and welcome.



Phase One - 2016-2017 Budget: \$400,000

- Transformed a garage into a Synagogue, JLI Lecture Hall, and Activity Room
- Converted a dark tool shed into a community kitchen
- Turned a mechanic shop into a Social Hall and Activity Room
- Exterior and Interior paint throughout the building
- LED Signage around building
- New flooring and updated washrooms on programs level
- Upgraded Youth Centre Classrooms, Community Lounge, Counselling and Meeting Room
- Improved communications and security systems

Phase Two - 2018-2019 Budget: \$488,000

- Removal of the wall between the Social Hall and Synagogue in order to open the space to a 2,500+ ft² hall
- Completing initial commercial (meat and pareve) kitchen including proper ventilation and appliances
- HVAC System for Social Hall, Synagogue, and Youth Centre Classrooms
- Upgrading the washroom facilities and installing a washer and dryer
- Improved fencing in the playground area for the safety of the children
- The Faigel Shapiro Kosher Pantry which provides food for those in need in our community
- Safety ladder and fencing for roof access
- With a Public Safety of Canada matching grant, upgrading our security system which will include the installation of:
 - o 26 security cameras and corresponding recording system
 - o security film on doors and windows
 - o LED lighting outside
 - o anti-graffiti spray
 - o updated alarm system
 - o expanded intercom system
 - o upgraded access system and locks
- Installation of fourteen new windows



Phase Three

Subject to, and when funding of \$600,000 is in place. Items to be implemented gradually based on available funding.

• Possible expansion of the current Social Hall and Synagogue to the south by way of a 2,500ft² addition to give us a total of 5,000ft²

The addition would be built to accommodate future upper levels. The addition would also allow for

- a lobby entrance
- coat room
- and division into separate room for programs and events
- Designing one sensory room, as a start, for the Friendship Circle of Calgary

The Friendship Circle provides services and support for children and teens with special needs through the help of trained teen volunteers and professional therapists.

- Building a grass field and play area on the west side of the property and general landscaping
- Sukkah Plaza Expansion from current 1,072ft² to over 2,000ft²
- Replacement of remaining windows

Future Phases, Dream, & Vision

Build a new 5,000ft² hall that combined will hold a Sanctuary, Banquet Hall (with stage) and Lecture Multimedia Rooms

A second level will accommodate activity rooms for the Friendship Circle, Youth Centre activities and a CTeen lounge

A third floor will accommodate twenty guest rooms for students and families for weekend, Shabbos, and Holiday programs

- Occupy a large state of the art facility to accommodate the ever-growing needed service in our community. This will also include a 'hang-out' facility for teens and young adults with special needs.
- A special Jewish group housing facility for adults with special needs who are in desperate need for such a Jewish home in Calgary

Chabad's Calgary Campus Zoning/Land Use Approved!

With sincerest of thanks and appreciation to everyone involved, the City of Calgary's City Council approved Chabad's land use rezoning application! What this means is that Chabad's Calgary Campus is no longer on industrial land.

The new commercial zoning will allow Chabad to build and dream our future with a gymnasium, playground, reception hall, swimming pool, mikvah, a kosher restaurant, housing for special needs adults, and many other amenities that are now possible.

A quick timeline of the past 2 years.

- July 16th, 2018: Land Use Application was submitted to the City
- October 17th, 2018: Open House held at Chabad Calgary Campus
 - Members from the City of Calgary planning division as well as members of the Board of Directors of the Fairview Community Association were on hand.
 - Many Fairview residents attended and the feedback Chabad received was overwhelmingly positive.
 - Over twenty Letters of Support from the neighbouring community and the Community Association were received.
- November 15th, 2018: The City presented a recommendation on Chabad's application to the Calgary Planning Commission (CPC).
 - The City Administration recommended that the CPC refuse our application (for technical reasons and guidelines they need to abide by).
 - The CPC voted in favour of having the City's recommendation be filed and that Council accept our redesignation application.
- January 14th 2019: Chabad's application was presented to City Council at a Public Hearing. Calgary's City Council voted unanimously and overwhelmingly to support Chabad's application.

We could not have done this without all of our supporters and friends. Thank you to everyone who has gotten us this far and let us keep momentum going as Chabad takes the next step towards the vision that is the Chabad Calgary Campus.
