

A PASSOVER MESSAGE FROM THE REBBE



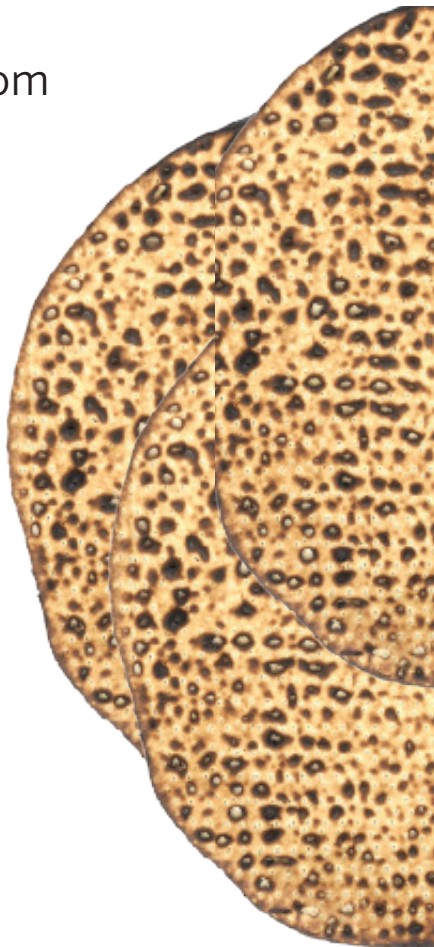

(or after 8:22 pm more lenient time)

2nd Seder Night

Light Candles* after 9:15 pm | Say Blessings 1 & 3

Drink 4 cups of wine and eat Matzah after 9:15 pm

Friday, April 10

Second Day of Passover

Light Candles* at 8:07 pm | Say Blessing 4

Tuesday, April 14

Light Candles at 8:14 pm | Say Blessing 1

Wednesday, April 15

Seventh Day of Passover

Light Candles* after 9:27 pm | Say Blessing 1

Thursday, April 16

Final Day of Passover
