Immediately upon awaking, recite this short prayer:

PASSAGE 2 - NETILAT YADAYIM

After waking up and getting dressed, before eating or reciting prayers, it is appropriate to wash your hands in the following manner:

- o Remove any removable objects from your hand, such as a ring (or dirt).
- o Fill a washing cup with water.
- o Pour it over the right hand from wrist to fingertips.
- o Proceed to do the same over the left hand.
- o Repeat this procedure two additional times.
- o Those who are left-handed reverse the order, and begin with the left hand.
- o Dry your hands. Then recite the blessing:

Blessed are you, L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us concerning the washing of the hands.

PASSAGE 3 - ASHER YATZAR

The following blessing is recited after the ritual washing of the hand:

It is revealed and known before the throne of Your glory that if but one of them were to be blocked, or one of them were to be opened, it would be impossible to exist even for a short while. Blessed are You, L-rd, who heals all flesh and performs wonders.

After reciting Asher Yatzar (and the Elokai Neshamah prayer, which can be found in the prayer book), we recite a number of short blessings of gratitude. The following are the first four in the series; the remainder can be found in the prayer book. It is customary to stand during the recitation.

Each morning, we recite three blessings about our Torah heritage, and the privilege that we have to study it and pass it along to the next generation.

-rd our G-d, make the teachings of Your Torah pleasant in our mouths, and in the mouths of Your entire people, the House of Israel; and may we, our children, and the children of Your entire people the House of Israel all be knowers of Your Name and students of Your Torah for its own sake. Blessed are You, L-rd, who teaches the Torah to His people Israel.

PASSAGE 6 - THE WRITTEN AND ORAL TORAH

After these three blessings, we proceed to perform the mitzvah of Torah study by reciting the following two passages—one from the Written Torah and the second from the Mishnah/Talmud.

May the L-rd bless you and guard you.

hese are the precepts for which no fixed measure is prescribed: Leaving the crops of the edge of the fields for the poor, the gift of the first fruits, the pilgrimage offerings brought when appearing before the L-rd on the three festivals, deeds of kindness, and the study of Torah.

These are the precepts, the fruits of which man enjoys in this world, while their principal [reward] remains in the world to come: Honoring one's father and mother, performing deeds of kindness, early attendance at the House of Study morning and evening, hospitality to strangers, visiting the sick, dowering the bride, escorting the dead, concentration in prayer, bringing peace between man and his fellow man and between husband and wife. And the study of Torah is equivalent to them all.
